Holiday Balloon Ornament



Included in your kit are:

- 7 ornament shapes
- * Ribbon
- Glue dots, 10 large and 4 small
- Paper clip

You will need to supply:

* scissors




Begin by noting the letters designating each ornament outline. Cut out the 7 ornament shapes arranging them from A-D as you go. There should be 1 shape A, and 2 each of B, C, and D as shown in Figure 2.

Separate the large glue dots from the small glue dots. On piece A attach 1 large glue dot to the top "neck" of 1 side and attach the end of your ribbon. The finished side of the ribbon should face out. Turn piece A over and attach a large glue dot on the opposite side. Fold the ribbon over and attach the other end to the glue dot as shown in Figure 3.






Set piece A in front of you and place 1 large glue dot on the neck of the ornament on the end opposite the ribbon. Use a piece B and line up the bottom edge of it's neck with the bottom edge of piece A (Figure 4).



Place 1 large glue dot on the bottom neck area of piece B and line up the bottom edge of the neck of piece C (Figure 5).



Place 1 small glue dot on the bottom edge of the neck of piece C and attach piece D, lining up the edges of each neck (Figure 6).

Turn the ornament over and repeat the previous 3 steps to attach the remaining pieces B, C, and D to the bottom edge of A.



If the bottom edges have trouble holding, use your paper clip to help hold the bottom of the ornament until the glue adheres and while completing the remaining steps. You may also add a staple or paper fastener to help hold it.

Working on 1 side at a time, flip the top layers of the ornament open until you see piece A with the attached ribbon. Place 1 large glue dot over the ribbon at

the top of the neck of the ornament and press piece B against the glue, lining up the top edges of the necks (Figure 7). Place 1 large glue dot on the neck of piece B and press piece C against it, lining up the top edges of the necks. Place a small glue dot on the neck of piece C, keeping it centered and towards the top edge. Adhere the outer piece D to the glue dot, lining up the top edges of piece C and D. Your ornament should resemble the one in Figure 8 below. Repeat the gluing for the opposite side of the ornament.





Your ornament is ready for hanging.

- Double sided cardstock in coordinating colors.
- * 1 piece of ribbon
- * Glue dots
- * Pencil
- * Scissors
- * Ornament pattern downloaded from the calendar page on limalibrary.com
