

# Holiday Spinner Ornament

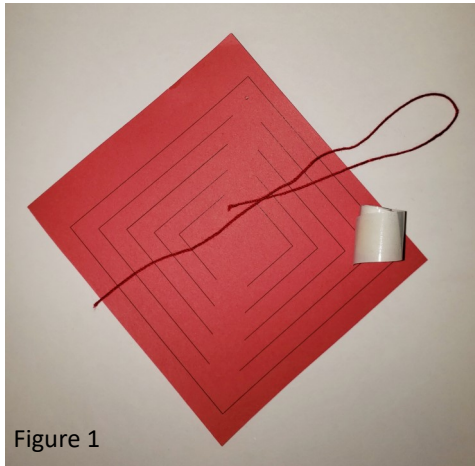

## Included in your kit are:

- \* 1 square of paper
- \* glue dots
- \* Piece of ribbon
- \* Direction sheet

## You will need

- \* **Scissors or craft knife**
- \* **Pencil**

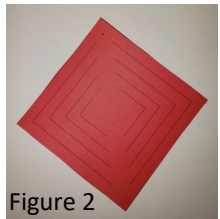

You should see a cutting guide printed on your paper square. Trim off the excess paper by cutting along the outer most box.

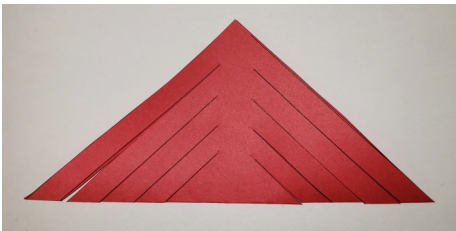

where the lines do not connect to meet the opposite corner. Now you can cut along the preprinted lines, cutting through both layers of folded paper, and unfold.

The next step is easier if you have a craft knife, but can be accomplished with scissors. If using a craft knife simply cut along the preprinted lines that are marked on your paper. Notice that they do not connect at the corners. If using scissors you can evenly fold the square in half, bringing the corner

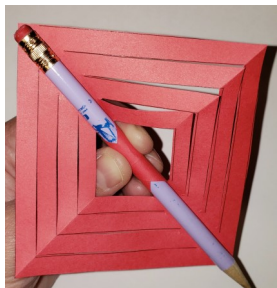

Starting with the inner-most square, gently curl both flaps in the same direction. A pencil is helpful to give a nice curl. See figures 4 and 5.

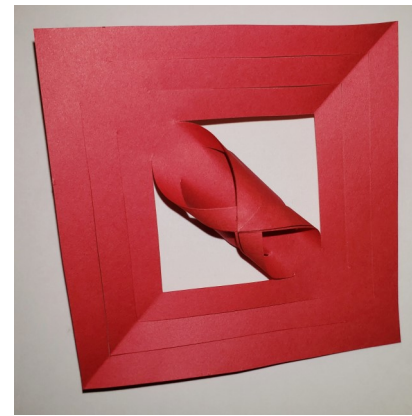

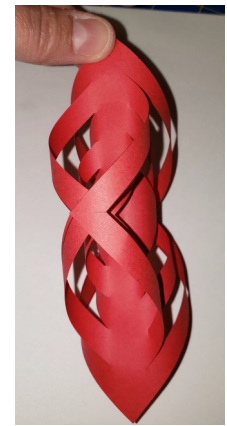

Turn the ornament over and bring the opposite corners of the next square together and attach using 1 glue dot (figure 6). Flip the ornament over and bring the next 2 corners together and fasten with a glue dot. Repeat these steps to fasten the 2 corners of the next 2 squares, alternating the side of the ornament each time. You should have a tubular-shaped ornament as shown in figure 7. Thread the string through the pre-punched hole in one corner of your ornament and knot the ends.



Your finished ornament is ready for hanging.

Don't have a kit or want to make more? You will need:

- \* Sheet of decorative paper cut to 3 3/4" , 4 inner consecutive squares are marked every 5/16" as shown in figure 2
- \* 10" piece of string
- \* Ruler
- \* Pencil
