

# Layered Loops Ornament

## Included in your kit are:

- 1 sheet of printed cardstock
- 1 paperclip
- 1 ribbon
- 1 direction sheet

## You will need:

- Scissors

The ornament is created by layering the pre-printed strips. On one side of your cardstock you should be able to see the outline of 5 rectangles of varying lengths and widths. Carefully cut out the 5 strips along the cutting lines. Do not cut too close to the pre-punched holes.

Start with the smallest strip and carefully bring the ends together to form a loop with the holes overlapping as shown in figure 3. You can use the paperclip to help hold it.

Continue adding loops to the ornament starting with the next shortest piece and continuing until all the loops are used. For each layer you will line up the holes on the ornament, pinning with the paperclip as you go as shown in figure 4.

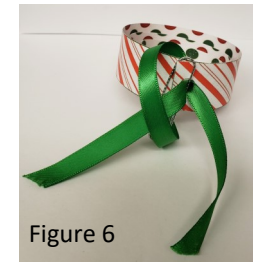

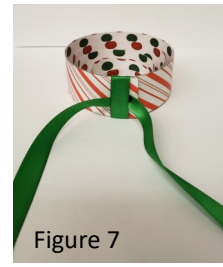

Using your piece of ribbon, lay it over the top of the ornament and bring 1 end around each edge and up through the hole and out the top as shown in figure 5. Adjust each ribbon end to go around either side of the ribbon crosspiece as shown in figure 6. Carefully pull the ribbon tighter to hold the loops together as shown in figure 7 and tie the ends in a knot around the crosspiece of ribbon. Knot the ends of the ribbon together to form a hanging loop and your ornament is ready to enjoy.



Your finished ornament is ready for hanging.

*Don't have a kit or want to make more? You will need:*

- \* 1 sheet of double-sided paper—cut the following sizes: 3 1/2" x 1/2", 5" x 5/8", 6 1/2" x 3/4", 8" x 7/8", and 9 1/2" x 1"
- \* 1 12" piece of ribbon
- \* Hole punch
- \* Scissors
- \* Ruler
- \* Pencil
- \* Paperclip, binder clip, or clothes pin for holding
