
Music Wreath Ornament




Included in your kit are:

- 9 rectangular pieces of sheet music
- 1 piece of twine
- 1 direction sheet


You will need:

• scissors




Fold in half along the original pre-fold so the holes are on the inside (Figure 3).

You should have 9 rectangles of paper. One sheet is pre-folded and has two small holes punched in it. Set this piece aside (Figure 1). Of the 8 remaining pieces set 1 aside, this is extra in case you make a mistake.





Using the piece of paper with the holes, fold the paper evenly in half lengthwise (Figure 2). Place the folded rectangle in front of you. The folded edge with the holes should be facing away from you.




Open the rectangle back up and thread the twine through the holes so the ends are on the side that will be hidden when re-folded (Figure 4). Tie the twine in a knot and trim the ends if needed. Refold the paper lengthwise, keeping the knot of the twine inside the folds. Adjust the knot as needed to accomplish the last fold.

Place the folded strip flat on the table so the open side of the fold is facing you and the holes with the twine are facing up. Fold the bottom left corner upwards to meet the top edge of the strip, forming a triangle. Repeat with the right-hand corner (Figure5). Fold the strip in half along the original pre-fold line so the top edge corners meet evenly and the twine loop is hanging out. Repeat the folding steps for each of the remaining 7 paper rectangles. These rectangles will not have holes and will not get twine hanging loops. You should now have 8 folded rectangles of paper, one with a hanging loop.





Hold the first folded paper with the hanging loop in your right hand with the longest edge facing away from you. Grab another folded piece in your left hand with the long edge facing away from you. The points on both pieces should face in the same direction. Insert the points of the piece in your right hand into the open slots on the piece in your left hand (Figure 6). These slots were created during the first fold and you should place one point in each slot.



Continue inserting points into new pieces to form a circular shape. One you have linked all the pieces together into a chain (Figure 7), gently position them to form a wreath shape and insert the points from your last piece into the open slots on the underside of the piece you started with (the one with the hanging loop). Adjust the folded pieces as necessary to achieve an evenly round shape.



Your decoration is now ready for hanging.

Don't have a kit or want to make more? You will need:

- * 8 rectangles heavier-weight paper, 8 cm x 4 cm.
- * Piece of thin twine that is 10" long.
- * Scissors, ruler, pencil, or additional tools to measure and cut.
